



# ***Indiana Invaders Fall Classic***

***September 9-11, 2011***

## **SECURITY PLAN**

Safety of all participants (players, coaches, referees, and spectators) is the very important to the Indiana Invaders FC and the organizers of the Indiana Invaders Fall Classic. If there are any questions regarding the security plan, please contact a Field Marshall, Site Coordinator, or the Tournament Director. Field Marshalls will be wearing fluorescent vests or t-shirts.

In order to provide a secure environment for all participants, the tourney will adhere to the following security plan:

1. It is expected that each ***coach*** and ***manager*** will monitor their players, parents and spectators to promote a positive, friendly and incident free tournament.
2. Each field will have a designated Field Marshall wearing a fluorescent vest or t-shirt. If an incident occurs, the Field Marshall, in coordination with the referees, will attempt to resolve the issue.
3. If needed, the Field Marshall will involve the Site Coordinator, Tournament Director, or Indiana Invaders management to resolve any incident. The Field Marshall is in contact with the Site Coordinator/Tournament Director at all times by radio or cell phone.
4. If all of the above does not resolve the incident, a uniformed officer will be summoned for assistance.
5. The tourney site will have either a uniformed officer at the site at all times, or local police department patrolling regularly at each site.
6. If the uniformed officer at the site is unable to resolve the incident, law enforcement will be called and the Participants involved in the incident will be removed from the site.
7. All significant incidents will be reported by the Tournament Director to the Participant's club and state association.
8. In the event of a significant injury, a Field Marshall will notify the Site Director via radio or cell phone to call an ambulance. The address of the complex will be posted at the Director's Tent to facilitate communication to the dispatchers. Also, the address will be taped to each radio and cell phone in case the Field Marshall determines it in the best interest of the injured party to call ambulance dispatch (911) directly. The emphasis is placed on immediate care to the injured/fallen participant.

9. Tournament management will maintain coolers with small bags of ice to use in case of minor injuries that deserve treatment. If a player is injured and requires ice, a Field Marshall will contact the Director's Tent by radio or cell phone to request delivery of the ice. Ice will be immediately delivered to the player either on foot or by motorized cart.

10. Stocked First Aid kits will be available at all sites at the Director's Tent.
